It is hereby notified for the general information of all concerned that the **Secondary School Certificate (Classes 9 and 10) Annual-II and Oriental Languages Examinations, 2026**, of the Board of Intermediate & Secondary Education, Bannu, will commence on **Wednesday, 7 October 2026**. The admission fee may be deposited at any branch of the National Bank of Pakistan or through **1 BILL**. The online submission schedule is set out below.

Instructions to Candidates & Institutions

- Private candidates shall submit their admission forms online through the https://portal.biseb.edu.pk/biseb_online_admission/ssc/entry/
- All regular/private candidates who passed the Class 9 or Class 10 Annual-I Examination, 2026, are eligible to apply for full improvement or for improvement in one, two, three, or more subjects.
- Candidates who have passed Class 9 in full may apply for improvement of marks in Class 9.
- Institutions shall submit online admission forms on the Board's website and provide a hard copy of the system-generated admission list, duly signed by the head of the institution, by the due date specified in this notification.
- A candidate who passed a paper with grace marks, or passed the examination on aggregate, and is applying for improvement must also reappear in the relevant paper; otherwise, the improvement result will not be considered.
- Private candidates seeking admission to Class 10 from another board must provide a proper migration certificate along with a verified DMC for the Class 9 examination.
- Roll number slips will be uploaded to the https://portal.biseb.edu.pk/biseb_online_admission/ssc/private/ and will be available for download seven days before the start of the examination.
- For re-appear candidates, no change of photograph will be allowed after the examination.
- Migrated candidates who passed the Class 9 Examination, 2026, through other boards shall appear through their respective boards for Class 9 improvement of marks in the SSC Annual-II Examination, 2026. Migrated candidates who failed shall also appear through their respective boards.
- Candidates attempting Class 9 improvement in the Annual-II Examination, 2026, shall not be considered position holders or eligible for any other awards or scholarships in the Annual-I Examination, 2027.
- Promoted Class 9 re-appear candidates are allowed to appear in the SSC Annual-II Examination, 2026, and the next Annual-I Examination, 2027.
- All regular/private candidates who appear for Class 9 improvement in the SSC Annual-II Examination, 2026, shall not be eligible to apply again for Class 9 improvement when applying for fresh admission to Class 10 in the SSC Annual-I Examination, 2027.

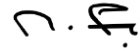
